Payment

Swimming programs must be paid in full when booking. Places will not be held without payment.

Missed lessons due to illness

Make up lessons will be offered for children who are too ill to attend their scheduled class. To be eligible, notice must be provided via email to swimschool@dicksonaquatic.com.au prior to the lesson commencing. Makeup lessons are entirely dependent on vacancy in future classes and are not always available. In the event there are no vacant positions available, a family pass valued at \$18.70 will be issued.

Cancellation

Program bookings cancelled may be eligible for a refund. Note that a \$30 cancellation fee will be applied to all cancelled bookings. To be eligible for a refund, 48 hours' notice prior to the program commencement must be given by emailing swimschool@dicksonaquatic.com.au.

Progression of levels and assessment

Dickson Aquatic Centre proudly use the Swim and Survive Program initiated by The Royal Life Saving Society of Australia. For more information about the specific swimming levels, please view information on dicksonaquaticcentre.com.au or speak to the Swim School Coordinator for further information.

Assessments are ongoing throughout each program as children develop at their own pace. At the end of each program the Swim School Coordinator will review all lessons and children. Please speak with the Swim School Coordinator regarding any queries or feedback. Certificates of participation are awarded to each child at the end of each program with Awards given to children as they achieve the course outcomes and are ready to progress to the next level.

Supervision

Adults responsible for supervising children at the Centre are not permitted to leave their child under 13 years of age at any time whilst at Dickson Aquatic Centre, including during swimming lessons. Active supervision during a child's swimming lesson is mandatory.

Emergency Action Plan

In the unlikely event of an evacuation please remain calm and follow the instruction of staff members at Dickson Aquatic Centre.

1. Listen for emergency PA announcement, Lifeguard or Swim School Co-ordinator instructions.
2. Instructors and children will exit the water.
3. Whilst ensuring everyone stays together, the class will walk calmly to the exit advised by the Swim School Co-ordinator. They will wait with their class at the assembly point.
4. The Swim School Co-ordinator will then mark the roll.
5. After the roll is marked, children may leave with parents.

Weather

Dickson Aquatic Centre continues to run their swimming lessons in most weather conditions. If lightning is within 10km of the area the pool will be evacuated and will remain closed until safe to reopen. Patrons are to follow Dickson Aquatic Centre staff instructions on evacuation. Dickson Aquatic Centre will advise parents of the opportunity to make up the missed lesson for lessons that have not commenced. We encourage parents to check our Facebook page for the most up to date information about the status of programs.

Public Pools Act (2015)

The Public Pools (Standards for Conditions of Entry and Removal) Determination 2016 (NO 1) made under the *Public Pools Act 2015* applies to all patrons of the Dickson Aquatic Centre. Details of this is displayed in the entrance to the Centre.
